SUBJECT: RESPONDING TO VIOLENT FELONY WARRANT CALLS FOR SERVICE

Effective immediately, the Communications Control Section (CCS) shall immediately process all calls for service involving arrest warrants for violent felonies via the Warrant Channel (Channel 9) and expeditiously dispatch them according to applicable Priority 1 or 2 incident type guidelines.

The Warrant Channel (Channel 9) dispatcher shall advise the dispatcher assigned to the affected Channel/District/Zone, to dispatch a zone car to the suspect's location/location of call for service **while the warrant is being verified.**

In addition, the dispatcher shall advise zone car personnel that the warrant verification is *in progress* and *a supervisor shall be notified.*

Every effort shall be made by the CCS to seek assistance from a supervisor of the Gang Impact Unit (GIU), NICE and/or Fugitive Task Force via radio broadcast. **The Deputy Chief of Field Operations, the Commander of Special Services and District Commander shall be notified via Code Red.**

THIS INFORMATION SHALL BE READ AT ROLL CALLS AND SUBSEQUENT REMINDERS MADE BY CCS SUPERVISORS.
