**PRETRIAL INTERVENTION PROGRAM
DEFERRED PROSECUTION AGREEMENT**

It being alleged that you have committed an offense against the State on or about 08/16/2022 to wit: Grand Theft over \$20,000, Organized Scheme to Defraud, False Claim on Travel Voucher (x4) and it further appearing after an investigation of the offense and into your background, it appears that the interest of the State of Florida, and your interest will best be served by the following procedures:

THEREFORE,

On the authority of **Jack Campbell**, State Attorney in and for the **Second** Judicial Circuit, prosecution in this matter for said violation will be deferred for the period of **24 months MONTHS** from this date, provided you abide by the conditions hereafter specified in this contract and order.

- 1) You shall refrain from violation of any law (local, state, and federal). In the event of a criminal arrest while on the diversion program, you are subject to automatic dismissal. You shall advise your PTI program officer of any new arrests.
- 2) You will work regularly at a lawful occupation or attend school.
- 3) You will participate in programs agreed upon in this contract under the supervision of the Department of Corrections. You shall make yourself available for all the services of this program.
- 4) You will not possess, carry or own any firearm. You will not possess, carry, or own any weapons without first procuring the consent of the PTI program officer.
- 5) You shall immediately inform the PTI program officer of any changes in your residence or employment.
You will not leave the county of your residence without first procuring the consent of your officer.
Residence verifications will be confirmed by postal mail and employment verification by pay stub only.
- 6) You shall answer truthfully all inquiries by the PTI program officer and allow visits at your residence, employment, school, or elsewhere and carry out any instructions given.
- 7) You shall pay restitution to the victim, in the amount specified in this order if applicable.
- 8) You shall pay cost of supervision in the amount of **\$50.00** per month plus 4% surcharge for a total of \$52.00 per month, unless otherwise waived according to Department Policy.
A 4% surcharge will be assessed to any monetary obligations.
- 9) You shall not use intoxicants to excess; nor will you visit places where intoxicants, drugs or other dangerous substances are unlawfully sold, dispensed or used.
- 10) You will submit to and pay for random urinalysis as instructed by your PTI program officer.
- 11) You will call the PTI program at (850) 488-3596 within 2 days of signing this contract to schedule an appointment. You will then report to your PTI program officer each month as directed. At the discretion of your PTI program officer, you may report every other month after six months, then non-reporting after twelve months.
- 12) Special Conditions: (eligible for E.T. after ½ way point UNLESS specifically noted below)
 - **\$500.00 fee** (money order or cashier check) payable to the State Attorney's Office upon filing of this agreement.

- **Complete current enrollment in Course for Gambling addiction.**
- **Enter into and attend regularly scheduled Gambling anonymous or any other Gambling addiction treatment or support group.**
- **Complete and turn in full allocation as to conduct alleged in criminal offense.**
- **May not serve in any position that allows her access to use the employer's funds or line of credit for her personal use or benefit**
- **100 hours of Community Service**
- **Pay \$649.98 of restitution to Florida Sports Foundation**

The State Attorney may, during the period of deferred prosecution, revoke or modify the conditions of your deferred prosecution by:

- A: Changing the period of deferred prosecution not to exceed an additional 6 MONTHS.
 B: Prosecuting you for this offense if you violate any of these conditions.
 C: Void this agreement should it be determined that you have a prior record of adult criminal convictions

If you comply with these conditions during the period of deferred prosecution, the charges herein shall be dismissed.

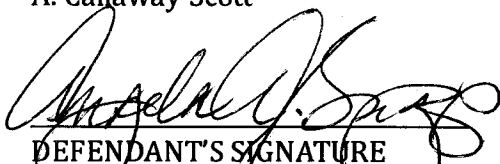
By signing this deferred prosecution agreement the defendant, **Angela Adams Suggs**, waives her right to a speedy trial for the period of his/her diversions under the Constitution and laws of Florida and the United States of America in the cause for which prosecution is being deferred. Further that he/she understands the contract and will abide by conditions in this contract. Your diversion period will begin on the date of the last signature date of the below three signatures.

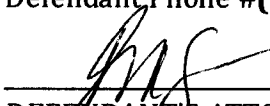
