ALLEGED COMPLAINT: REFERRED BY CC PUBLIC RESPONSE - MULTIPLE FOOD TRUCKS PARKING IN THE 5100 BLOCK OF W. FORD AVE (SE CORNER OF BLUE DIAMOND AND DECATUR). USUALLY ARRIVING AT 9:30 AND LEAVING AROUND 3:30 P.M. DAILY. ONGOING ISSUE FOR ALMOST 2 YEARS.--INSPECTOR COMMENTS:

Action at Blue Diamond and Decatur Cross streets, behind Dignity Health Center.

Joint Complaint investigation with EHS B. Bucher

Complaint validated, and inspection was conducted resulting in a closure due to inadequate refrigeration. Refer to inspection report by EHS B. Bucher for more details.

INSPECTOR OBSERVATIONS: Complainant stated that unit operates in dirt lot from 9:30 am until 3:30 pm. Operator confirmed they park from this time until approximately 2pm, exceeding the 30 minute time limit when operating without an approved waiver. Operator parked within 250ft of another mobile vendor at time of complaint investigation. Multiple cars driving into dirt lot stirring up dust and creating possible contamination issues. Operator was informed that they must apply for a waiver with all applicable documents (permission letter), and that they can only park on paved areas. Operator was observed vacating area after complaint investigation.

The complaint filed with the Southern Nevada Health District (SNHD) noted on this report has been found to be valid. A verified complaint fee of \$118 must be paid at the 280 S Decatur Blvd SNHD office within the next five business days or your permit may be subject to suspension.
