Narrative:

On Friday, 10/25/19 at about 0518 hours, I was dispatched to the Cannery Caisno at 2121 E Craig Road in reference to a vehicle that crashed into the front casino entrance doorway. Other patrol units were already on scene prior to my arrival.

On scene, I saw a white and green motorhome sitting/parked inside the northeast casino entrance. The motorhome had extensive front end damage. There was glass and metal laying all around the motorhome both outside and inside the casino entrance.

During this time I was advised that an employee, later identified as _____, who was cleaning the casino entrance was struck by the motorhome when it crashed into the glass doorway. _____ was transported to UMC Trauma in critical condition. Officer Frabbiele responded to UMC Trauma to check on his condition. See his report for further details.

Both Officers J. Simpson and S. Hayes contacted me stated they obtained the following information; the driver of the motorhome, later identified as Jennifer Stitt, made a spontaneous utterance that the Cannery owed her money and she did this (crashed into the casino) because she was trespassed from the property yesterday. See both Officers Simpson and Hayes follow-up reports for details.

I met with one of the casino managers identified only as _____ escorted me to the video surveillance room where I saw the following footage of the incident: On camera 516 at about 05:02:20 the motorhome is seen driving NLVPD Detectives in the northeast parking lot of the Cannery during an unrelated incident. On camera 517 at about 05:05:15 hours the motorhome is seen exiting the Cannery parking lot on the north side onto Craig Road (east of the parking garage). On camera 536 at about 05:13:40 hours the motorhome is seen entering the Cannery parking lot from Craig Road and Cannery Road (west of the theater). On Camera 510 at about 05:15:40 hours the motorhome is seen traveling east through the valet section and then abruptly turn towards the casino entrance. On camera 507 at about 5:15:45 the motorhome is seen crashing into the casino glass entrance striking _____ who was cleaning in the breezeway in between the two glass entrances. I could see _____ get pushed up against the inside entrance with his chest, and his back against the front of the motorhome. _____ was visibly stuck

and trying to escape from the pressure between the motorhome and the glass. On the same camera at about 5:15:54 (nine seconds later) the motorhome is seen accelerating forward about another 10 feet. At this point _____ disappears under the motorhome before the Cannery security is seen attempting to pull him to safety. On Camera 146 at about 5:16:00 the driver, Jennifer, is seen exiting the motorhome and lays on the floor facedown while the Cannery security take her into custody.

Due to the statements made by Jennifer, and the fact she moved the vehicle forward on top of _____ after she had already stopped in the first crashing incident into the casino, I determined there to be probable cause to arrest her for attempted murder with a deadly weapon. Jennifer was transported and booked at the LV City Jail accordingly.

The undersigned makes the following declarations subject to the penalty of perjury and says: That I am a peace officer with the CITY OF NORTH LAS VEGAS POLICE DEPARTMENT Clark County, Nevada. Being so employed for a period of 13 (7) years (months), that I learned the following facts and circumstances which lead me to believe that the above named subject committed (or was committing) the offense of SEE ABOVE CHARGES at the location of 2121 E CRAIG and the offense occurred at approximately _____ hours on the _____ date of _____ 20 _____
