

The County Clerk does not have the authority to make an interpretation of an Executive Order or provide legal advice. I did not draft or distribute this letter. This is unauthorized use of the name and office of the Van Buren County Clerk. The matter has been turned over to the Van Buren County Sheriff's Department for investigation.



## PANDEMIC FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST



Your request for information was approved on 02-Oct-2020 and was met with the following information:

- The April 2020 E-O mandating masks, social distancing guidelines and other pandomic requirements is now null and void as of the October 2020 ruling.
- 2. As a result of the above, employers, businesses, gyms, etc CANNOT deny you entry for refusal to wear a mask as doing so would be unlawful.
- Fallure to follow the above guidelines by a business would be direct contempt to the Michigan Supreme Court and would result in fines and or imprisonment.
