

Dear Mr. Oller,

Each and every one of them is prepared to sit down with the Diocese and tell the true character of Monsignor Craig. There is not one person of sound mind who has spent any time at all with Monsignor who is not rocked by the unfairness of this process. You are dealing with a servant of the church and Christ who has comforted the dying and the surviving. This servant has followed the path of Pope Francis and worked with the most damaged and addicted in our community. He deserves just treatment.
