Introduction

The Montana State University Billings Poll was first conducted by Dr. Craig Wilson in 1989. At that time, it was named the Eastern Montana College Poll. The Poll became the Mountain States Poll in 2019. This report provides a summary of the statewide random sample of 343 Montana residents. Phone numbers were provided by Scientific Telephone Samples (STS) using the method of random digit dialing (RDD). The Poll was generously funded by the Department of Social Sciences and Cultural Studies, the College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences, and the Office of the Provost at Montana State University Billings.

This year, the Mountain States Poll was conducted from October 3-14, 2022 in the Market Research Lab in the College of Business. The margin of error for the poll is 5.29%, with various subgroups having larger margins of error. Cross-tabulations are provided based on a variety of demographic information and party affiliation. The results are weighted based on reports from the Census.





1. Do you plan to vote in the 2022 midterm election?





2. At this point in time, do you approve or disapprove of President Joe Biden's performance in office?





8. Are you in US House District 1 or 2?





9. If you had to choose today, which of the following candidates would you choose to support for House Representative in District 1?





14. Do you trust your representatives' ability to govern efficiently and in a non-divisive manner?




