AFFIDAVIT

NOW COMES The State of Oklahoma by and through Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation Special Agent Meric Mussett, the Affiant, being duly sworn and upon Oath, states as follows:

I, Meric Mussett, am a Special Agent for the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation (OSBI). I have been employed in law enforcement in the state of Oklahoma since 2020. I have been a commissioned police officer in and for the State of Oklahoma since 2024. I was previously employed by the OSBI as a Technical Investigator in the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Unit and a Physical Evidence Technician at the OSBI Long Term Storage evidence facility. My training and education include a Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training Basic Certificate, a Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice from the University of Central Oklahoma in Edmond and a Bachelor's Degree in Forensic Science from the University of Central Oklahoma in Edmond. Your affiant also obtained specialized training for the examination of digital evidence items. In July of 2022, your affiant became a certified user of Advanced Digital Forensics – Digital Evidence Investigator. In December of 2022, your affiant became a Cellebrite Certified Logical Operator and a Cellebrite Certified Physical Analyst. In February 2023, your affiant completed the ICAC Investigative Techniques bootcamp.

I swear and affirm the following information is true and correct to the best of my knowledge:

1. On April 7, 2026, at approximately 1419 hours, VICTOR LEE HAWKINS walked into the southeast entrance of the Pauls Valley High School with two loaded semi-automatic pistols.
2. After HAWKINS walked into the school, he pointed a firearm at a student, later identified as juvenile K.P., sitting in the foyer, and HAWKINS attempted to discharge his weapon. The weapon malfunctioned and did not fire.
3. HAWKINS stepped behind a vending machine in the foyer to clear the malfunction.
4. HAWKINS then stepped out from behind the vending machine and pointed his weapon at another student, later identified as juvenile C.O, in the foyer. HAWKINS then discharged his firearm inside of the school.

5. Juvenile C.O. put his hands up and asked HAWKINS to not shoot him. HAWKINS lowered his weapon and told juvenile C.O. to leave. Both juvenile K.P. and C.O. ran out of the southwest entrance of the school.
6. As a result of the gunfire, Pauls Valley High School Principal, KIRK MOORE then ran out of his office and attempted to apprehend HAWKINS.
7. HAWKINS discharged his firearm again and shot MOORE in his right lower leg.
8. MOORE wrestled with HAWKINS on a bench in the foyer and was able to remove HAWKINS' pistol from his hand.
9. MOORE and the Pauls Valley High School Assistant Principal laid on top of HAWKINS on the bench until Law Enforcement Officers arrived.
10. HAWKINS was taken into custody and transported to the Garvin County Detention Center without incident.

INTERVIEW OF VICTOR HAWKINS

11. On April 7, 2026, Your Affiant and OSBI Special Agent RADFORD DEW interviewed HAWKINS at the Garvin County Detention Center.
12. Your Affiant verbally read HAWKINS his Miranda Rights. HAWKINS verbally acknowledged he understood his rights, and agreed to talk with OSBI Agents.
13. HAWKINS provided the following information
 - a. HAWKINS graduated from the Pauls Valley High School in May of 2025.
 - b. At approximately 1400 hours, HAWKINS decided he would go to Pauls Valley High School with the intent of killing students, faculty, and finally himself.
 - c. HAWKINS entered his father's room and went into his closet where he knew his father kept his firearms.
 - d. HAWKINS took two of his father's pistols and his father's black Dodge pickup truck and drove to the school.
 - e. HAWKINS entered the school, pointed his pistol and yelled for everyone to get on the ground.
 - f. HAWKINS then pointed his pistol at a female student (juvenile K.P.) in the foyer. HAWKINS pulled the trigger of the firearm, but it did not go off.
 - g. HAWKINS then stepped out from behind the vending machine and pointed his gun at a male student (juvenile C.O.) in the foyer.
 - h. Principal MOORE then came out of his office and charged at HAWKINS.
 - i. HAWKINS fired his weapon and it struck MOORE.

- j. HAWKINS was tackled by MOORE and then was arrested.
- k. HAWKINS wanted to conduct his own school shooting like the Columbine shooters did.
- l. HAWKINS did not like Principal MOORE, therefore, HAWKINS went to the high school to kill MOORE.

Based on the information, I pray that this Honorable Court issue a finding of fact that probable cause does exist to believe that the crime(s) of:


(2 counts) Unlawful Carry (21 O.S. § 1277)

Shooting with intent to kill (21 O.S. § 652 A)

(2 counts) Pointing a firearm (21 O.S. § 1289.16)


Has been committed and that there is probable cause to believe that **VICTOR LEE HAWKINS**, the defendant, committed these crimes.

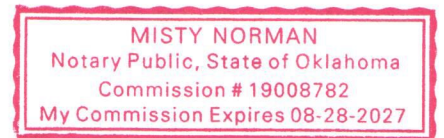
