On behalf of over 300 concerned residents and business owners along the Alameda corridor, we are reaching out to express serious concerns about the proposed changes to Alameda Avenue in

the Wash Park area.

While we understand the goal of improving safety and traffic flow, our community strongly believes that removing a travel lane to add turn lanes will:

- Increase congestion and backups on Alameda,
- Push frustrated drivers into nearby residential streets, including Virginia Avenue, creating new safety hazards,
- Harm the accessibility and economic vitality of our local businesses, and
- Require future, reactive interventions due to unintended traffic and safety impacts.

Attached to this email, you will find:

2. Over 300 resident and business owner signatures in opposition to the project, and
3. A recent Denver Gazette article highlighting the issue.

We respectfully request that the City pause this project and engage with our community to find a safer, more effective solution before proceeding.
