

Building Overview:

- Security officers are stationed at the entrance throughout the executive hallway
- There are (2) entrances to the Superintendent's office:
 - The main entrance is through the executive suite
 - The Superintendent's executive secretary's office is an anteroom and as a result anyone entering the Superintendent's office must pass through the executive secretary's office first
 - In addition, there is a side door to the Superintendent's office that is accessible through the kitchenette in the executive hallway
 - That door is not monitored or locked and could be conceivably accessed by anyone

Technology:

- The television in question in the Superintendent's office is a Samsung TV
 - Samsung TV Plus is the platform for the channels
 - It does not have any external sources like an Apple TV or Firestick
 - OMES and the Oklahoma County Sheriff's Office were both at OSDE yesterday and inspected all associated devices in question
 - Additionally, they have conducted multiple interviews including one with Superintendent Walters
 - After meeting with OMES yesterday, it was their belief that there is not a way that someone could stream or airplay to the Superintendent's Samsung TV
 - At no point during the day did the Superintendent log into any platform with any personal login for streaming services
 - None of the Superintendent's devices (personal or otherwise) have ever been connected to the TV
 - Samsung customer service has advised that it is not possible to recover a log of the TV's history nor is it possible to recover the television programming guide for the day of the board meeting

Board Day:

- On the day of the board meeting, as is standard practice, Oklahoma Highway Patrol met the Superintendent in the parking lot and walked him into the Department of Education
- Once inside, the general counsel, acting board secretary, and chief of staff met with the Superintendent in his office immediately preceding the SBE meeting, approximately 9:05am CDT
 - This meeting lasted approximately 5 minutes, at which time the parties left the office and the SBE meeting began
- The open meeting started at 9:34am CDT and lasted one hour and fifty-two minutes, at which time the regular meeting adjourned into executive session at 11:06am CDT
- The Superintendent and the board's acting secretary entered the Superintendent's office first

- The Superintendent's office secretary was already in the office setting up for lunch
- The acting board executive secretary noticed that the TV was on Fox News
- A parent who was in Executive Session for a transfer appeal stated via e-mail that there was "nothing but professionalism" (see attached)
- There were 24 members of the public who signed into the meeting
- There were 13 members of the media present
- There were 7 state troopers present
- As a result of the law enforcement questioning, the Superintendent Walters was never alone in the State Department without someone else (law enforcement, staff, fellow board members) the entire day of the board meeting
