- FRONT BAR AREA HAS PLANS TO BE RELOCATED WITH ADDED EQUIPMENT, SUBMIT A REMODEL APPLICATION AND PLANS TO FOODREV@SNHD.ORG
- REPAIR WALLS TO GOOD CONDITION IN FRONT SERVICE AREA
- ELIMINATE SMALL NAIL SIZED HOLES ON WALLS NEAR WARE WASH AREA
- REPAIR COVED BASE IN ALL FOOD AREAS
- REPAIR DAMAGED WALLS
- REPAIR DAMAGED FLOORS, RESEAL AREAS AS NECESSARY, REPAIR MISSING/BROKEN FLOOR TILES
- SEAL GAPS BELOW/AROUND EXTERIOR DOORS
- TRIM AND SEAL EXPANSION FOAM ON CEILING ABOVE WARE WASH AREA
- HOT WATER AT HAND SINK FLUCTUATES BETWEEN 86-100F. HOT WATER OF 100F MINIMUM IS REQUIRED. REPLACE HOT WATER HEATER
- HOT WATER AT 3 COMPARTMENT AT 118F. HOT WATER OF 120F MINIMUM IS REQUIRED. SMALL WATER HEATER IS NOT ADEQUATE FOR DEMAND.
- REPLACE 3 NON-SANITATION CERTIFIED CHEST FREEZERS. EQUIPMENT MUST BE SANITATION CERTIFIED BY NSF OR EQUIVALENT
- REPLACE INEFFECTIVE NON-SANITATION CERTIFIED AIR CURTAIN ON BAR DOOR
- ELIMINATE FLIES, FLIES OBSERVED NEAR GHOST TOWN CAFE'S EXTERIOR DOOR - MAINTAIN DOORS CLOSED, ENSURE DOOR IS TIGHTLY SEALED, KEEP AREA CLEAN AND DRY, RELOCATE WET MOPS AND SOILED BROOMS
- REPLACE 3 NON-SANITATION CERTIFIED PIZZA BAKERS
- RESURFACE OR REPLACE HEAVILY SCORED CUTTING BOARD ON SANDWICH COOLER
- DISCONTINUE USING "BEER COOLER" FOR OPENED FOODS. THIS COOLER IS FOR PACKAGED BEVERAGES ONLY
- REPLACE CRACKED LIGHT SHIELD, CLEAN LIGHT SHIELDS
- REPAIR DAMAGED DOOR THRESHOLDS/DOOR FRAMES
- INSTALL A MOP SINK, ENSURE FLOORS AND WALLS AROUND MOP SINK IS CLEANABLE (SUCH AS FRP)
- REMOVE ALL FOIL FROM EQUIPMENT, ENSURE EQUIPMENT IS CLEAN AND IN GOOD CONDITION
- SNHD WAIVER REQUIRED FOR INDOOR GREASE INTERCEPTOR

PUSF - TCS TRAILER

- PROVIDE SCREENS ON TWO LARGE WINDOWS
- REPLACE CRACKED LIGHT SHIELDS
- WASTE WATER FOUND ACTIVELY LEAKING ONTO GROUND. WASTE WATER TANK IS OVERFLOWING AND BULGING. REPLACE NSF WASTE WATER TANK. CLEAN WATER TANK MUST BE INSTALLED PROPERLY INSIDE TRAILER. CLEAN WATER TANK MUST BE 50 GALLONS MINIMUM. WASTE WATER TANK MUST BE 15% LARGER THAN CLEAN WATER TANK. PROVIDE A WASTE WATER DISPOSAL/PUMPING PLAN.

What You Should Know About COVID-19 to Protect Yourself and Others

What is coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19)?

COVID-19 is an illness caused by a virus that can spread from person to person. The virus that causes COVID-19 is a new coronavirus that has spread worldwide. Symptoms can range from mild to severe illness. People can also be asymptomatic (no symptoms) and still spread the virus to others.

How does COVID-19 spread?

The virus is primarily spread from person to person. You can become infected from:

- Close contact (about 6 feet or two arm lengths) with a person who has COVID-19.
- Respiratory droplets when an infected person coughs, sneezes, or talks.
- Touching a surface with the virus on it, then touching your mouth, nose, or eyes.



Practice social distancing.

Buy your groceries and medicine, go to the doctor, and complete your banking activities online as much as possible.

- If you must go in person, stay at least 6 feet away from others.
- Always wear a cloth face covering that covers your mouth AND nose.



Know your risk for severe illness.

- Everyone is at risk of getting COVID-19.
- Older adults and people of any age who have serious underlying medical conditions may be at higher risk for more severe illness.



How can I protect myself and others from COVID-19?

There is currently no vaccine to protect against COVID-19. The best way to protect yourself is to avoid being exposed to the virus that causes COVID-19.

- Stay home as much as possible and avoid close contact with others.
- Wear a cloth face covering that covers your nose and mouth in public.
- Wash hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with 60% alcohol if soap and water aren't available.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces.



Prevent the spread of COVID-19 if you are sick.

Stay home if you are sick, except to get medical care when needed.

- Avoid public transportation, ride-sharing, or taxis.
- Separate yourself from people and pets in your home.
- If you need medical attention, call ahead of time so your medical provider can take the appropriate precautions.
