Overall Inspection Comments

ALLEGED COMPLAINT: COMPLAINANT STATES A RAT RAN OUT FROM UNDER A BENCH IN A BOOTH, STAFF STATED THEY KNEW ABOUT THE RATS AND THERE WERE MORE IN THE KITCHEN / BACK AREA.--INSPECTOR COMMENTS:

Person in charge unaware of specific complaint and indicates only one sighting outside a door approximately one week prior. At time of inspection rodent droppings observed throughout facility (kitchen, bar, and dining area) with harborage conditions present.

Establishment closed for operating under a gross insanitary condition considered an imminent health hazard. SNHD Closure sign posted. Do not move, remove, or block closure sign. Facility is to remain closed until licensed pest control treatment has been completed, harborage conditions have been eliminated, and this has been verified by SNHD. Contact inspector Ray Campa at CAMPA@SNHDMAIL.ORG or at (702) 759 -1110 to schedule a re-inspection. A facility closure fee of \$716 must be paid at the 280 S. Decatur Blvd SNHD office prior to re-inspection. You may also pay online by visiting www.snhd.info and clicking on the "Pay an Environmental Health Invoice" link. Call SNHD at (702) 759 - 1110 to obtain an invoice number to pay online. Closure approved by EHS Senior Christy Munaretto.

Last licensed pest control completed on 1/7/19 with no evidence of rodent activity present. Complete licensed pest control service and correct the following items prior to re-inspection.

1. Clean all rodent droppings throughout facility in a safe manner (reviewed CDC recommendations for cleaning of rodent droppings).
2. Seal gaps under patio door and keep interior doors closed when not in use.
3. Keep doors to receiving warehouse closed when not in use.
4. Repair leaks near soda bibs. Discard soda bibs and seal tubing as needed.
5. Repair overflowing floor sink at dish area and remove all standing water and food debris.
6. Repair leak under soda machine and clean area.
7. Repair leaks under bar sinks and remove all standing water and food debris.
8. Remove all food debris from underneath dish racks and storage racks.
9. Clean and sanitize all exposed dish and glass ware near areas where droppings present in kitchen and bar.
10. Clean and sanitize all dining tables and counters near areas where droppings present.

Person in charge is aware that requests for inspections outside of normal operating hours (8:00 - 4:30 M-F) require approval and may be subject to additional fees.
