NARRATIVE

Narrative:

On 06/22/2022 at approximately 1506 hrs, I was on patrol in Collier County Florida in a C.C.S.O patrol vehicle when the following took place:

I was responded to the area of I-75 northbound, just north of the exit 111 on ramp, in reference to a shooting.

Subject , will be identified as AM throughout this report. Subject Andrew Williams, will be identified as AW throughout this report. Subject Thomas Yanoti, will be identified as TY throughout this report.

Multiple CCSO units and I responded and arrived on scene.

TY had fled the scene before Deputies arrived.

A crime scene was established.

AM had received injuries from broken glass during the incident. AM was treated on scene by EMS for injuries.

Detective Booth #2789 was notified, arrived on scene and was on the case.

Detective Booth collected statements from AM and AW.

AM advised he was traveling on Immokalee RD. AM passed TY on Immokalee road. When AM got in front of TY, he felt a "bump" as if his and TY's vehicles had made contact. Both vehicles proceeded on the on ramp to go northbound on to I-75. Once on I-75, TY cut AM off and forced him on to the shoulder. AM advised he thought TY wanted to exchange insurance information. TY got out of his vehicle, produced a handgun and started shooting at AM while AM was still in his vehicle. AM was able to lay down and was not hit by any of the rounds. When TY stopped firing, AM sat up to see if TY was gone. TY continued to shoot at AM. AM laid back down to try and protect himself from being shot. The shooting had stopped and TY eventually left.

AM advised at this time he wished to go to the hospital for further treatment. AM was transported to the Hospital.

AW advised he and his family were on the east shoulder of I-75 northbound, just north of exit 111. AW advised his vehicle had blown a tire and he was attempting to repair it. While attempting to repair the tire, he and his wife heard what they thought were gunshots coming from AM and TY vehicles which were south of them. TY got in his vehicle and left. AW saw the damage to AM's vehicle from the shooting

Crime Scene Tech Eisele #4473 and Crime Scene Tech Peterson #3161 responded to the scene and processed the scene.

Bald Eagle Towing responded and towed AM's vehicle to CCSO property and evidence. Detective Ventura #3247 followed the vehicle to CCSO property and evidence.

The crime scene was broken down at this time.
