We urge you to institute a statewide mask mandate, which medical experts agree can save thousands of Arizona lives.

We urge you to reach out to President Trump and Leader McConnell and call on them for swift passage of a comprehensive COVID-19 relief package.

We urge you to work with the State Legislature to increase unemployment benefits in Arizona beyond their current maximum of \$240 — the second-lowest weekly unemployment benefit of any state in the Union, and the lowest nationwide in percent of lost wages replaced.
