PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT

On 11-13-21 at approximately 0245, I, Det. L. Mathews # 2039 responded to 6009 Holly Rd. (Star Financial Credit Union) reference a shooting. Upon my arrival, I contacted several Patrol Officers and Lt. Tuley. I observed a vehicle bearing TX LP - [REDACTED] (Black Ford Fusion) to be wrecked out in the STAR Credit Union parking lot with several air bags deployed. The Fusion had several bullet holes on the passenger side of the vehicle. I observed a female whom was later identified as (VI2) [REDACTED] to be sitting in the driver seat unconscious and not breathing with a lot of blood on her face; she was deceased on scene from at least one gunshot wound. I learned two other females, (VI1) [REDACTED] and (VI4) [REDACTED] had been transported to Bay Area Hospital for injuries they sustained. I was advised (VI1) [REDACTED] had been shot in the kneecap and (VI4) [REDACTED] had been grazed by a bullet in her arm and had shattered glass shards upon her body. I was advised (VI3) [REDACTED] and (VI5) [REDACTED] were detained in patrol units on scene; they did not receive any injuries that needed hospitalization. All five victims were occupants of the black Fusion. (VI3) [REDACTED] and (VI5) [REDACTED] were transported to CID for interviews. I was also advised there were two witnesses who were walking on Holly Rd. at the time of the incident. (WI1) [REDACTED] and (WI2) [REDACTED] were transported to CID for interviews.

Det. M. Ramos went to Bay Area Hospital and interviewed (VI1) [REDACTED] and (VI4) [REDACTED]

Det. M. Pena # 6867 assisted me at the scene and with the interviews at CID. Through all the interviews, Det. Pena and I learned that (VI2) [REDACTED] was driving eastbound on Holly Rd. with her four other victim occupants. They were being followed by an SUV. The SUV pulled alongside the Fusion and began shooting into the Fusion. [REDACTED] lost control of her car and crashed into the easement / sidewalk of 6009 Holly Rd. From the victim and witness interviews, Det. Pena and I were able to get a consistent SUV description, description of the driver and occupant of the SUV and consistent timeline and account of events. Most importantly, we were advised (VI2) [REDACTED] had a GoPro camera mounted in her vehicle. Det. Pena and I were able to view the contents of the SD card within the GoPro which showed the sequence of events. From that footage, it could be seen the SUV was a red 2015 Dodge Journey, bearing TX LP [REDACTED]. The Journey pulled up next to the Fusion on the passenger side of the Fusion, shot into the Fusion and then sped past the Fusion as the Fusion crashed.

I contacted the registered owner of the Journey, [REDACTED] who advised me that her son, (OF3) Esten Chavez was in possession of her vehicle. Chavez was contacted and transported to CID to be interviewed. Chavez's common-law-ex-wife, (O5) [REDACTED] was with Chavez and also transported to CID to be interviewed.

At approximately 2007 hours on 11-13-21, [REDACTED] was read the Miranda Warnings and waived her Rights by providing a statement to Det. Pena and I. In [REDACTED] interview, she stated she was with Chavez when he shot at a passenger car on Holly Road. [REDACTED] learned of the injuries of the victims through social media later in the morning on 11-13-21.

At approximately 2202 hours on 11-13-21, Chavez was read the Miranda Warnings and waived his Rights by providing a statement to Det. Pena and I. Chavez was also interviewed and confessed to shooting at a small passenger car on Holly Road. Chavez learned of (VI2) [REDACTED] death through social media and knew her death was a result of him shooting at her vehicle.

After the interview, I advised Chavez was going to be arrested for Murder. Chavez became irate and used his physical strength to resist the arrest in the CIDR1. Capt. McMenamy and I placed handcuffs on Chavez but he tried to walk out of the CID room. Capt. McMenamy and I were able to get Chavez onto the carpeted floor of the CID room but he continued to try and get up and kick at us. Ofcr. J. Deleon heard the commotion within the CID room and had to come to our aid to gain physical control over Chavez. Chavez was eventually placed in leg shackles and chain from the ankle shackles to his handcuffs.

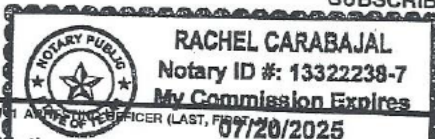
