- From I-17 NORTH, take EXIT #339 / LAKE MARY RD/MORMON LAKE
- Turn Right on S LAKE MARY RD go 21 miles
- Turn Right on Mormon Lake Village exit
- Continue 7 miles to lodge

HAPPY JACK LODGE

- From I-17 NORTH, take EXIT #339 / **LAKE MARY RD/MORMON LAKE**
- Turn Right on S LAKE MARY RD
- Continue 38 miles to MILE POST 292.5

() WEST OF FLAGSTAFF

ACCESS FROM 1-40 TO OAK HILL SNOWPLAY AREA

- From I-40 WEST go 17 miles, take EXIT #178
- Turn Right and go to Historic Old Route 66
