Facts & Circumstance that support probable cause to arrest the above named person are

On 09/09/2026 at 0940 hours Hughes County Central Dispatch received a 911 call from Terry Beck at 733 8th street in Stuart Oklahoma. Mr. Beck reported to the dispatcher that he had just shot his wife (Dena Beck), and that she was on their bed in a bedroom at 727 8th street in Stuart Oklahoma. Mr. Beck said he shot her in the back, and that he unloaded the gun he had used and put it on the counter near the kitchen outside of the bedroom. County Deputies responded to Stuart. Deputy Don Murry arrived and made contact with Mr. Beck outside of 727 8th street in Stuart. I arrived at approximately 1007 hours. I saw Deputy Murry standing by his unit. I went into the house at 727 8th street to check on Dena Beck. I found her lying on her right side with blood on the front of her shirt and her arms clutching her chest area. I saw a bullet casing on the bed behind Dena Beck. I checked for vital signs but was unable to feel or see any signs of life. Dena was not breathing and was not responding to my calling out. I went outside and Deputy Murry told me that Mr. Beck admitted to shooting Dena Beck.

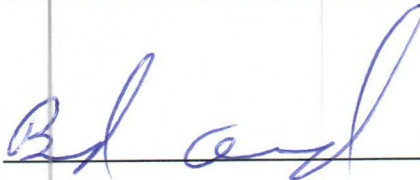
I placed Mr. Beck in my patrol truck and drove him to the sheriff's office. At the Sheriff's office during an interview Mr. Beck stated he had woken up around 8:00am or 8:30am and picked up a Ruger 9mm pistol from under his side of the bed. He said he thought about shooting himself and had held the gun to his chest a few times but couldn't pull the trigger. He said he then started pointing it at his wife who was still asleep and lying on her right side facing away from him. He said he pointed the gun at her back and moved it away several times when while pointing it at her back the gun went off shooting her in the back. He said she never moved or made any sounds. He said he walked out of the bedroom, unloaded the gun and set it on a counter. He said he then called 911 and waited for Deputies to arrive.

I transported Mr. Beck to Seminole County jail and booked him into Seminole County jail charged with Murder.

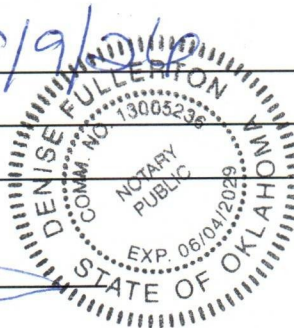
