**Statement of Probable Cause:**  
 Angelica Munoz entered child's school without permission and entered classroom and immediately assaulted teacher by shoving him over several desks causing minor injuries, abrasions and bruises. Several other teachers and students attempted to pull Munoz off teacher as she continued striking him with hands and fists. After teachers and students pulled her off teacher she continued yelling profanities at teacher as he lie on the ground on his back in defensive position. Munoz then picked up chair and raised it above head and began to try and strike teacher as 13-juvenile who tried to intervene to protect teacher was struck with chair causing minor injuries to right arm, bruises abrasions. Incident occurred during normal school hours and in the presence of many students. Two other teachers in neighboring classrooms heard disturbance and left their respective classrooms to intervene.
