**DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER**

**WHEREAS**, the County of Nueces on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of September 2021 is under threat of imminent disaster, injury, loss of life or property resulting from flooding, severe weather conditions, and potential hurricane conditions caused by Tropical Storm Nicholas; and

**WHEREAS**, Governor Abbott on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of September 2021 in response to severe weather threats along the Gulf Coast due to Tropical Storm Nicholas ordered the Texas State Operations Center (SOC) to increase its readiness on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of September 2021 so that "it is prepared to assist local officials in their response to Tropical storm Nicholas."

**WHEREAS**, Governor Abbott on the same day stated, "As the storm approaches Texas, I urge our Southeast Texas and Gulf Coast communities to prepare now to protect themselves and their loved ones from the severe weather conditions that Tropical Storm Nicholas will bring."

**WHEREAS**, the County Judge of Nueces County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF NUECES COUNTY:**

1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for Nueces County pursuant to § 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. Pursuant to § 418.108(b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued, or renewed, by the Commissioners Court of Nueces County.
3. Pursuant to § 418.108(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk.
4. Pursuant to § 418.108(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the County emergency management plan.
5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
