AFFIDAVIT FOR SEARCH WARRANT

I, Lt Danny Elliott, being of lawful age, first being duly sworn, state as follows: I am a Deputy Sheriff for the **Wagoner County Sheriff's Office** assigned to the **Criminal Investigations Division** and have been so employed for the past approximately **14 years** and have been a certified Peace Officer with the State of Oklahoma since 2009. During my employment as a Deputy I have been involved in several felony investigations as defined in various titles of Oklahoma Statutes.

I have probable cause to believe that the following property constitutes evidence of a crime as defined under Oklahoma Statutes.

PROPERTY TO BE SEARCHED FOR:

Copies of all paperwork, including voter signature pages for the Convening of a Grand Jury in Wagoner County for 2025 after the Wagoner County Board of Elections returned to the Court Clerk with a final legal count of signatures. These pages should be produced with no redactions.

LOCATION DESCRIPTION

The location to be searched has a 911 address of 307 E Cherokee, Wagoner Oklahoma 74467 in the main courthouse of Wagoner County. This property is a public facility. Your Affiant has been to the Wagoner County Court Clerk's Office. Your Affiant can return.

As probable cause for believing that said property may be found at the aforesaid location, I allege, and state as follows:

PROBABLE CAUSE

On April 24, 2025 an entity under the name of Wagoner County Citizens against corruption, LLC. filed a petition with the Wagoner County Court Clerk for the purposes of convening a Grand Jury to investigate allegations against Wagoner County Sheriff, Chris Elliott and District 27 District Attorney, Jack Thorpe, as well as other employees of the Wagoner County Sheriff's Office. Statutorily, the petition had the burden of obtaining

approximately 4700 legal, registered Wagoner County voter's signatures to proceed. The petition had approximately 45 days to complete the signatures required. Ultimately, at the end of the time period in June, the petition failed to garner the number of signatures needed.

During the process of obtaining signatures, petitioners stood on street corners, went door to door, used mailers, made soliciting phone calls, used websites to set appointments to gather signatures, and used social media to coax registered voters into signing the petition. During this process, reports of salacious lies were reported being told by petitioners about the allegations in the petition in order to coax citizens into signing the petition. According to Oklahoma Statutes (i.e. OS 21-1593) it is a felony to falsely obtain signatures on a Grand Jury petition by lying about facts that pertain to the allegations of the petition. According to the Oklahoma Statutes, to intentionally give false information to obtain a signature is committing fraud.

Wagoner County Sheriff's Investigator's received under cover audio/visual recordings from citizens that will prove that at least one petitioner was caught on recording telling multiple, salacious lies about the allegations within the petition in order to obtain signatures from Wagoner County registered voters. As criminal investigations go forth on this crime, the requested records from the petition are important to further the investigation.

Wagoner County, Oklahoma, or any of her duly appointed and authorized deputies, or to any constable or policeman of Wagoner County, or peace officer of the State of Oklahoma, including any Drug Task Force Officer/investigator with the 27th Prosecutorial District, Trooper of Oklahoma Highway Patrol, Agent of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs, Agent of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, or Special Agents and Task Force Officers of the Drug Enforcement Administration, Special Agent of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms, or any other state or federal peace officer, commanding that he search the office described herein, or premises the curtilage thereof and appurtenances thereto and to take possession of the property hereinbefore described and detain the same as provided by law, and make a written return thereof according to law.
