The grand jurors of Coconino County, Arizona accuse:

TERRELL STOREY

On this 2/12/2026 charging that in Coconino County, Arizona:

Count 1  
First Degree Murder

On or about February 4, 2026, TERRELL STOREY, acting either alone or with one or more other persons, committed or attempted to commit Burglary in the First Degree, in violation of A.R.S. § 13-1508, and in the course of and in furtherance of such offense, or immediate flight from such offense, TERRELL STOREY or another person caused the death of Hunter Bennett, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-1101, 13-1105(A)(2), 13-701, 13-702, 13-703, 13-751, 13-752 and 13-801, a class 1 Felony.

Count 2  
First Degree Murder

On or about February 4, 2026, TERRELL STOREY, acting either alone or with one or more other persons, committed or attempted to commit Burglary in the First Degree, in violation of A.R.S. § 13-1508, and in the course of and in furtherance of such offense, or immediate flight from such offense, TERRELL STOREY or another person caused the death of Robert Skankey, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-1101, 13-1105(A)(2), 13-701, 13-702, 13-703, 13-751, 13-752 and 13-801, a class 1 Felony.

Count 3  
Aggravated Assault

On or about February 4, 2026, TERRELL STOREY, using a semi-automatic rifle, a deadly weapon, intentionally placed Ty Furr, an employee of a law enforcement agency, in reasonable apprehension of imminent physical injury, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-1203, 13-1204(A)(2), 13-1204(H), 13-3105, 13-701, 13-702, 13-703, and 13-801, a class 2 Felony.

The State further alleges that the offense charged in this count is a dangerous felony because the offense involved the discharge, use, or threatening exhibition of a semi-automatic rifle, a deadly weapon, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-105 and 13-704.

Count 4  
Aggravated Assault

On or about February 4, 2026, TERRELL STOREY, using a semi-automatic rifle, a deadly weapon, intentionally placed Cody Stowe, an employee of a law enforcement agency, in reasonable apprehension of imminent physical injury, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-1203, 13-1204(A)(2), 13-1204(H), 13-3105, 13-701, 13-702, 13-703, and 13-801, a class 2 Felony.

The State further alleges that the offense charged in this count is a dangerous felony because the offense involved the discharge, use, or threatening exhibition of a semi-automatic rifle, a deadly weapon, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-105 and 13-704.

Count 5  
Aggravated Assault

On or about February 4, 2026, TERRELL STOREY, using a semi-automatic rifle, a deadly weapon, intentionally placed Gregory Kane, an employee of a law enforcement agency, in reasonable apprehension of imminent physical injury for the first time, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-1203, 13-1204(A)(2), 13-1204(H), 13-3105, 13-701, 13-702, 13-703, and 13-801, a class 2 Felony.

The State further alleges that the offense charged in this count is a dangerous felony because the offense involved the discharge, use, or threatening exhibition of a semi-automatic rifle, a deadly weapon, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-105 and 13-704.

Count 6  
Aggravated Assault

On or about February 4, 2026, TERRELL STOREY, using a semi-automatic rifle, a deadly weapon, intentionally placed Raymond Bauer, an employee of a law enforcement agency, in reasonable apprehension of imminent physical injury for the first time, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-1203, 13-1204(A)(2), 13-1204(H), 13-3105, 13-701, 13-702, 13-703, and 13-801, a class 2 Felony.

The State further alleges that the offense charged in this count is a dangerous felony because the offense involved the discharge, use, or threatening exhibition of a semi-automatic rifle, a deadly weapon, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-105 and 13-704.

Count 7  
Aggravated Assault

On or about February 4, 2026, TERRELL STOREY, using a semi-automatic rifle, a deadly weapon, intentionally placed Shane Ciminski, an employee of a law enforcement agency, in reasonable apprehension of imminent physical injury, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-1203, 13-1204(A)(2), 13-1204(H), 13-3105, 13-701, 13-702, 13-703, and 13-801, a class 2 Felony.

The State further alleges that the offense charged in this count is a dangerous felony because the offense involved the discharge, use, or threatening exhibition of a semi-automatic rifle, a deadly weapon, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-105 and 13-704.

Count 8  
Aggravated Assault

The State further alleges that the offense charged in this count is a dangerous felony because the offense involved the discharge, use, or threatening exhibition of a semi-automatic rifle, a deadly weapon, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-105 and 13-704.

Count 9

The State further alleges that the offense charged in this count is a dangerous felony because the offense involved the discharge, use, or threatening exhibition of a semi-automatic rifle, a deadly weapon, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-105 and 13-704.

Count 32

Count 35

On or about February 4, 2026, TERRELL STOREY recklessly endangered Robert Robertson with a substantial risk of imminent death, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-1201(A), 13-701, 13-702, 13-703, and 13-801, a class 6 Felony.

The State further alleges that the offense charged in this count is a dangerous felony because the offense involved the discharge, use, or threatening exhibition of a semi-automatic rifle, a deadly weapon, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-105 and 13-704.

Count 38  
Endangerment


