**AFFIDAVIT AND APPLICATION FOR ARREST WARRANT
AND TO SEAL AFFIDAVIT FOR THE PERSON(S) OF:**

Matthew Doloff 03/07/1990 a White male, 5'11" 145 lbs., brown hair, blue eyes
For C.R.S. 18-3-102(1)(a) Murder in the First Degree a Class 1 Felony

I, Detective Daniel Tregembo, 05041, the Affiant, state under oath that the facts known to the Affiant which establish probable cause to believe that a criminal offense was committed, and that the offense was committed by the above named person(s), are the following.

On Saturday, October 10, 2020 at approximately 3:30 p.m. Lee John KELTNER 08/14/1971, and [REDACTED] 02/[REDACTED]/1995, began walking southbound from Civic Center Park, after attending an organized rally. Uniformed Officers from the Denver Police Department, Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office and Douglas County Sheriff's Office were assigned duty for crowd control. Lee and [REDACTED] along with multiple other people, crossed W. 14th Ave. toward the passage between the main branch of the Denver Public Library (10 W. 14th Ave., City & County of Denver) and the Denver Art Museum. This path was identified as the route of egress from the rally. While walking, Lee John KELTNER and [REDACTED] 09/[REDACTED]/1993 engaged in a verbal dispute. Both men yelled and postured, leading several witnesses, including [REDACTED] 10/[REDACTED]/1986, to believe the men may engage in a physical altercation. [REDACTED] 08/[REDACTED]/1960 inserted himself between Lee KELTNER and [REDACTED] urging both men to stop.

This dispute, which lasted several minutes, was captured on Denver HALO cameras, as well as cell phone video and digital photography from multiple witnesses.

Review of the video and still images show [REDACTED] 01/[REDACTED]/1995 and Matthew DOLOFF 03/07/1990 become engaged in an altercation with Lee KELTNER while he is arguing with [REDACTED]. At this time Lee KELTNER is observed holding a can of OC spray. At approximately 3:36 p.m. Lee KELTNER turns his attention toward [REDACTED] and Mr. DOLOFF. Mr. KELTNER and [REDACTED] face each other and Mr. KELTNER strikes Mr. DOLOFF in the side of the head with an open hand. Mr. DOLOFF is then observed drawing a handgun from his waistband, aiming at Lee KELTNER and shooting once, striking Mr. KELTNER, as Mr. KELTNER discharges his OC spray. Mr. KELTNER collapsed to the ground.

Uniformed officers quickly responded and took custody of Mr. DOLOFF who was still holding a semiautomatic handgun.

Lee KELTNER was transported by ambulance to Denver Health Medical Center and pronounced deceased by Dr. HOELM at 4:05 p.m.

Based on these facts, your Affiant is respectfully requesting an **ARREST WARRANT and to SEAL the AFFIDAVIT** pursuant to **Rule 41** of the Colorado Revised Statutes, to have this Affidavit sealed from public release of the information herein contained, due to the media coverage of this case to assure that this case is not compromised and that the witnesses mentioned in this warrant can be protected from any type of early reprisals; for arrest of **Matthew DOLOFF 03/07/1990**, for the
