Narrative

On 02-03-2020 I responded to Edgemere St and Essex Ave for a Charlotte County School bus vs dog. Upon arrival, I observed a black and tan shepherd on the ground and appeared to be in the final stages of death.

I spoke with Robert Ossander who is Laia's owner. Robert stated he was walking against traffic at the curve, when bus 1702 came towards him and his dog began to bark. The dog was a 7 year old female German Shepherd who was on a leash and collar. The dog lunged out as the bus was passing and was ran over by the rear tires. He stated it was the dogs fault.

I spoke with Susan Komula who was driving bus 1702. She advised that she saw Robert walking the dog and moved over to the other lane. As she went by, the dog lunged out and was ran over by the back tires. She advised there was no damage to the bus

I observed no damage to the bus. I called and spoke with Animal Control who stated they would respond and handle the incident. A short time later, the dog passed. Animal called me back and I advised them the updated status of the dog. They advised since the dog passed they would no respond and the owner was present. I advised Robert of the updated status and advised him the dog could be buried. NFA
