

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COVID-19 HOME TESTING

IMPORTANT: CAREFULLY FOLLOW ALL TEST KIT DIRECTIONS TO ENSURE THE MOST ACCURATE RESULTS

HOW DOES IT WORK?

The COVID-19 over-the-counter rapid antigen home test is designed for home use. Antigen tests detect proteins from the virus that causes COVID-19 in respiratory specimens. They are authorized by the FDA under Emergency Use Authorization.

CAN IT BE USED FOR CHILDREN?

Many home tests (including BinaxNOW, Quidel and CareStart) are authorized for use on children over age 2 if the sample is taken by an adult. Consult package directions for brand-specific guidelines.

HOW SOON WILL I GET RESULTS?

Results are available in 15 minutes.

WHEN SHOULD I TEST?

You can use this test with or without symptoms of COVID-19. Test twice over 3 days, with 24-48 hours between tests. To maximize the benefits of rapid testing, take your test immediately before going out, not the day before.

HOW ACCURATE IS THE TEST?

Rapid antigen tests are more sensitive in people with symptoms and during the first week of symptoms. If a test is taken early in an infection, the virus may not trigger a positive result. For best results, follow the directions carefully and take two tests 24-48 hours apart.

WILL THE TEST DETECT VARIANTS?

All COVID-19 tests are being continually monitored for its effectiveness against variants. They are effective in detecting Omicron and other known variants of COVID-19.

WHAT IF I'M TRAVELING?

This at-home test will not qualify for travel-related clearances or release from isolation. For more information about tesing for travel, go to cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/travelers/testing-international-air-travelers.html

SEE OTHER SIDE FOR HOW TO REPORT RESULTS

IF TEST IS NEGATIVE

- If you are symptomatic or have had an exposure to COVID-19, it is recommended that you follow up with another COVID-19 test 24-48 hours later to confirm.
- If a test is taken early in an infection, the virus may not trigger a positive result.
 You may still have an infection and could be contagious later. You should still exercise caution to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
- To maximize the benefits of rapid testing, take your test immediately before going out, not the day before.

IF TEST IS POSITIVE

- Stay home and isolate yourself from others.
- Seek medical care if necessary.
- Notify any close contacts.
- Report your positive result to RiverStone
