City, Community Partners to Hold Groundbreaking for Major Redevelopments at Chamberlain, Berry Parks

(Tulsa, OK) - The City of Tulsa Parks, Culture & Recreation Department will host a groundbreaking ceremony to celebrate the start of construction on the redesigned Chamberlain and Berry Parks on Monday at 1 p.m.

The Chamberlain Park project will transform the 15-acre park into a regional hub for recreation and community gatherings, featuring a new 24,000-square-foot Jane A. Malone Community Center, expanded amenities, new trails, and major site upgrades.

The event will also highlight progress on the redesign of Berry Park, another key North Tulsa project focused on creating flexible community space, shaded gathering areas, updated athletic amenities, and new stormwater infrastructure.
