## RULE TO SHOW CAUSE WHY BRIAN POPE SHOULD NOT BE REVOKED FOR FAILING TO COMPLY WITH CONDITIONS OF PROBATION

On August 29, 2018, Brian Pope appeared in open court, was placed on probation, and sentenced to serve 30 days in the parish jail with all but 168 hours suspended. The Court had no objection to the 168 hours being served on house arrest with electronic monitoring supervised by the Lafayette Parish Sheriff's Office. Brian Pope was given credit for the time served in accordance with LSA-C.Cr.P. Art. 880. Probation Brian Pope was placed on two years unsupervised probation, subject to the following conditions of probation: Pursuant to the provisions of Article 895 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, probationer is ordered to and shall comply with all GENERAL CONDITIONS set forth in Louisiana Code of Criminal Procedure Article 895 and the following SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

Probationer Brian Pope was ordered to perform 173 hours of community service in the form of public instruction about proper compliance with the Louisiana Public Records Act, and the adverse consequences for the public and the official, which result from the failure to comply with that act. He was further ordered to submit his proposed program of instruction and target audiences for approval prior to his initiation of any of this type of community service. The proposed plan of instruction was to be submitted to this court not later than 3:00 p.m. on September 28, 2018. In the alternative, defendant shall perform litter abatement at the rate of at least 8 hours a month.

As of present date, Brian Pope has not provided proof of community service work or in the alternative litter abatement hours at a rate of at least eight hours per month. Accordingly, Brian Pope is ordered to show cause on the 10th day of August 2020 in Lafayette Parish, Louisiana, why his probation should not be revoked for failing to comply with his conditions of probation. The Lafayette Parish Clerk of Court shall serve all parties associated with the above captioned matter with notice of the rule to show cause hearing date.
