Facts & Circumstance that support probable cause to arrest the above named person are

253rd E Avenue, Broken Arrow in Wagoner County. On arrival, Broken Arrow Fire Paramedics found the 3yr old child, Faith Seaman unresponsive and without a pulse. CPR was administered on scene and enroute to St Francis Children's Hospital. Faith was pronounced deceased by the Emergency Room Doctor at the hospital. As there were no obvious reasons why the healthy 3yr old had died, the Oklahoma Medical Examiner's Office took possession of Faith's body for further investigation.

Faith's parents, Glen and Kelsey Seaman (Suspects) told paramedics, deputies, and DHS that they did not know why Faith had died. Glen and Kelsey described Faith as a healthy child. Glen and Kelsey stated that Faith had complained of a stomach ache the night before the 911 call. Prior to the autopsy of Faith's body, bruising was found on Faith's buttocks, butt, and face. With that information Wagoner County Sheriff's Investigators, as well as DHS asked Glen and Kelsey if Faith had had any physical accidents prior to the 911 call. Glen and Kelsey stated no. Glen and Kelsey were asked how discipline was administered to Faith. Both Glen and Kelsey stated that they did not spank, but instead would put Faith into "time out."

During the autopsy, the Pathologist found that Faith had several severe injuries, including two broken ribs that were broken in two places each. Also found were deep bruising and internal damage to organs. According to the Pathologist, these injuries were consistent with child abuse. According to the Pathologist, the injuries to Faith occurred just prior to Faith's death.

In interviews, both Glen and Kelsey denied any physical abuse, but later admitted that there was a history of hard spankings to Faith, including pulling Faith's pants down and harshly spanking with a belt.. Both Glen and Kelsey admitted that on 11/05/19 Faith was beaten with a bamboo spoon to the point the spoon broke. Both Glen and Kelsey stated that there had been a lot of stress in the home, i.e. money, discipline issues, and sleep deprivation. Kelsey stated that during the beating of Faith on 11/05/19 she fell on Faith and may have broken Faith's ribs. Neither Kelsey or Glen took Faith anywhere to receive medical care. Faith Seaman confessed to DHS workers during an interview that Faith's death was the result of the abuse she committed on Faith on 11/05/19.

Probable cause is as follows:

1. Faith Seaman is a minor under the age of 18

- 2. Glen and Kelsey Seaman are the parents and caregivers to Faith Seaman
3. Faith Seaman did die from injuries administered upon her from Kelsey Seaman
4. Kelsey Seaman did commit child abuse upon Faith Seaman
5. Glen and Kelsey Seaman did willfully commit child neglect by not getting medical aid to Faith Seaman after having knowledge of injuries she sustained during child abuse.
6. Glen Seaman enabled the child neglect on Faith Seaman by not getting Faith Seaman medical aid, and reporting the child abuse.
7. Both Glen and Kelsey Seaman obstructed law enforcement by lying or omitting important information that would have furthered the investigation into Faith Seaman's death and abuse.

Based on the above information, I have probable cause to believe that Kelsey Seaman committed the crimes, 1st Degree Murder involving and resulting in the abuse of a child, Child Abuse, Child Neglect, and Obstructing an officer during an investigation.

Based on the above information, I have probable cause to believe that Glen Seaman committed the crimes, Enabling Child Neglect, Child Neglect, and Obstructing an Officer during an investigation
