



IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Bixby Public Works Authority Did Not Meet Monitoring Requirements

Our water system recently violated drinking water requirements pertaining to the contaminant(s) of concern listed below. Although none of these violations are considered emergencies as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we are doing, or have done, to correct these violations. Customers are not at risk and there is no reason to suspect any potential adverse health effects. Alternative water supplies are not needed.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During the following monitoring periods, we did not monitor or test for the following contaminant(s), and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

Type Sample(s): Lead & Copper Monitoring Period(s): July 1, 2025- December 31, 2025

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time. This violation does not require any action on your part.

What happened? What is being done?

The required Lead and Copper monitoring was not completed within the specified monitoring period. Upon notification, the Bixby Public Works Authority has taken corrective action by scheduling and completing the required sampling and submitting all necessary documentation to the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ). Procedures have been reviewed and updated to ensure all future monitoring and reporting requirements are completed on time.

We anticipate resolving the problem by this date: June 30, 2026
