



THINGS TO KNOW

2020-21 BLUE HAWK FOOTBALL AT THE BAC

1. Students, faculty and staff must claim a FREE ticket through Eventbrite and have a certified ticket to attend the game. ID cards will not be accepted for admission to the event.
2. ALL general admission tickets will be available to the public prior to each home game. Tickets must be purchased in advance through dsubluehawks.com (Eventbrite).
Suite holders and blue ticket season ticket holders do not need a GA ticket.
3. General admission ticket entrances will be at the north and south patio gates. Suite holders and game day workers can enter through the main entrance.
4. Access to the Lowman-Walton concourse will be available ONLY to suite holders, game day workers and individuals that need special seating accommodations. All individuals must display proper credentials to gain access to the building. Credentials will be provided to suite holders prior to the start of the season. For individuals who need special seating accommodations, please visit the ticket booth on game day or contact the appropriate athletic department prior to game day.
5. Proper face coverings will be required inside the Lowman-Walton concourse and BAC suites except when eating or drinking.
6. Outdoor seating will be arranged so that social distancing can be maintained to the greatest extent possible while fans are seated. Where social distancing is maintained, fans do not have to wear masks while in their seats, but fans are expected to wear masks when not in their seats, e.g., when entering or exiting the BAC, when purchasing concessions.
7. Concessions and restrooms will be available on both north and south patios. Suite guests can access the traditional concessions area inside the concourse. The use of debit and credit card is highly recommended for concessions.
8. Fans can download the FanFood mobile app to order from your seat and pick up your order without waiting in line.
9. Fans are not allowed to enter the track or field at any time.
