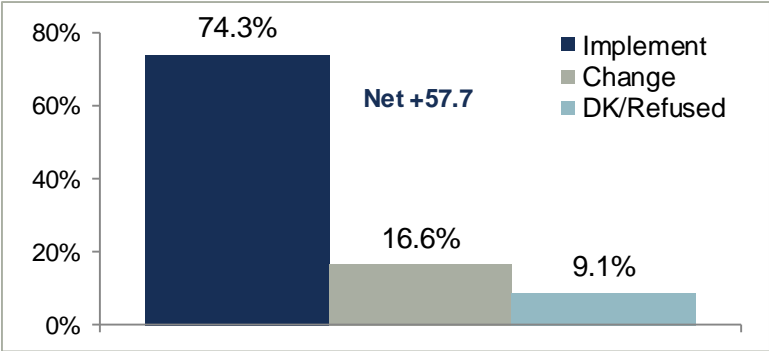

- The legislature should change the law passed by voters

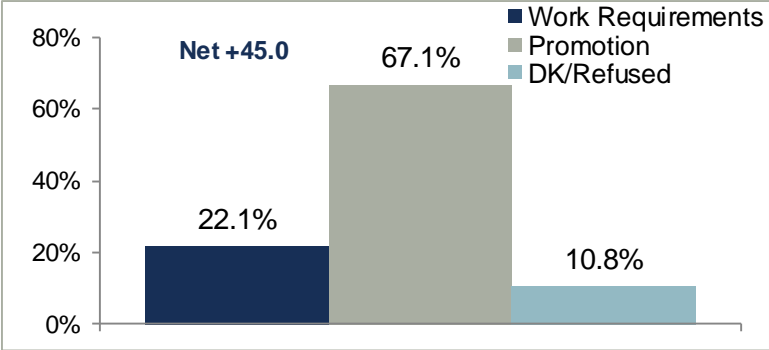

Which of the following comes closer to your opinion?

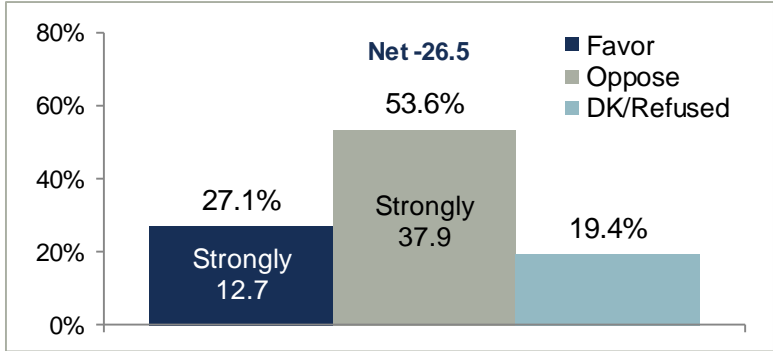

# Proposition 2: \$2 Million for Administrative Costs

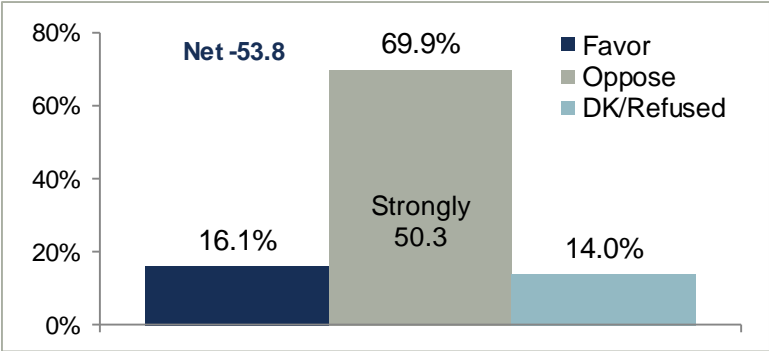
