- Leave:
- up to 2 weeks paid (max \$5,110) if quarantined
 - up to 2 weeks paid (max \$2,000) to care for family member
 - up to 10 weeks FML (max \$10,000) to care for minor/dependent child

ORGANIZATION

INMATE HOUSING PLAN IMPLEMENTED MARCH 24th

(based on CHS/Public Health and CDC guidelines)

- Cohorts: New Bookings stay together 14 days, until they pass incubation period
- Quarantined:
 - Group/Cohort in a pod that had symptomatic inmate
 - Each inmate will be tested
 - Stay quarantined until 2 negative tests / COVID ruled out
- Medical Observation: Inmate positive or highly at risk (being tested)
- Recovered Housing: Inmates after recovery stay together
 - All releases from quarantine or changes to medical status of an inmate or pod is at the direction of CHS
 - CHS began testing inmates for COVID March 20th (1st positive 4/30/20)

INMATE HOUSING AND TESTING

PPE

- ▶ N-95 masks always in stock. Supplemented with KN-95 masks 4/17/20.
- ▶ Surgical Masks for all staff & inmates were added and distributed 3/24/20.
- ▶ Cloth masks for Sworn staff were distributed the week of 5/1/20.
- ▶ Cloth masks for Detention staff were distributed the week of 5/12/20.
- ▶ In total, the following PPE has been procured and distributed:

Total amount spent on PPE and other supplies from February 2020 to July 2020 is: \$428,578.01

- ▶ MCSO staff teleworking initiated 3/17/20
- ▶ Employees required to wear a face mask in the workplace.
- ▶ All MCSO employees have additional 80 hours of Emergency Paid Sick Leave
- ▶ Daily communications Office-wide
- ▶ Established internal COVID-19 workgroup on 3/12/20 comprised of Detention, Sworn and Civilian Personnel
- ▶ Created Employee Pantry on 3/19/20 to support employees with critical items not readily available. 92 families received support.
- ▶ Banner Health and Phoenix ER & Medical Hospital (Chandler) offer priority testing.
