Implementation of COVID Protocols

Guide for implementing and enforcing COVID protocols for 2021-22 school year

- Establish and communicating common definition of “The Why” (messaging) to students, families, educators, leaders
- Expectations
 - Adhere to handbook
 - Maintain social distancing guidelines
 - Wear mask
- Violations – Reckless Endangerment
 - Intentional exchange of bodily fluids (coughing, sneezing)
 - Refusing to wear mask
 - Refusing to maintain social distancing guidelines
 - Leaving designated area
- **Response**
 - Add response level – Code Progression
 - 1st Offense: Code 102 (Noncompliance With a Reasonable Request) Conference with Student emphasizing the safety protocols of COVID-19 .
 - 2nd Offense: Code 102 (Noncompliance with a Reasonable Request) Conference with Guardian emphasizing the safety protocols of COVID-19 and Collaborative Referral Initiated.
 - 3rd Offense: Code 303 (Noncompliance With an Administrative Directive or an Assigned Disciplinary Response)
 - 4th Offense: Code 420 (Reckless Endangerment)
 - Intentional exchange of bodily fluids (coughing, sneezing) may result in an initial use of Code 420: Reckless Endangerment
