DEFENDANT DID THE FOLLOWING ACT(S) WHICH CONSTITUTE A VIOLATION OF THE LAW (ELEMENTS OF THE CRIME / PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT)

I, Megan Noel, being a Deputy Sheriff and a Detective with the Collier County Sheriff's Office, Animal Cruelty Alliance, did conduct an investigation and had probable cause to believe and do believe the following facts:

Robert Garon (suspect/arrested) did commit Cruelty to an Animal. Robert Garon intentionally committed an act to an animal/Buzz Light-year/canine when he had custody of the canine. This act knowingly and willfully caused injuries to the dog. This torment killed the canine. This occurred in Collier County at the suspect's residence on or around 07/29/2022.

On 08/02/2022, The Collier County Sheriff's Office Animal Cruelty Alliance was informed of this investigation by the Department of Animal Services of Collier County.

On 07/29/2022, the canine was brought into the Emergency Pet Hospital located at 6530 Dudley Drive, Naples, FL. The canine was a five-month-old Golden doodle.

The canine presented with possible head trauma, showing bruising to the right ear and the mouth. X-rays also showed contusions to the lung. The records indicate the canine was wet, unable to breathe normally, and disoriented. The canine failed to pick its head up and was not able to stand. Bloodwork also indicated muscle damage throughout the body. The staff treated the canine, but the canine expired from his injuries. The records showed the dog may have died from a "possible brain bleed."

On 07/31/2022, DAS was notified, and Senior Animal Control Officer Himaras responded to the Emergency Pet Hospital. , DAS completed an Activity report, and the body of the canine was transported to Domestic Animal Services by Officer Himaras.

On 08/02/2022, the Collier County Sheriff's Office transported the canine body to the Humane Society of Naples, and Dr. John Morton performed a necropsy on 08/03/2022.

Dr. Morton noted the following:

"Physical examination of external and internal anatomy revealed multiple, purposeful, blunt force trauma injuries to the abdomen, lumbar region, and head. The trauma resulted in severe bruising in the muscles and the tissue overlying the skull, as well as significant internal bleeding likely from multiple liver lacerations."

"This dog's death was caused by non-accidental, blunt force trauma to the head and body with secondary internal hemorrhage. I believe he suffered significantly from his injuries before death." The suspect intentionally committed acts to inflict pain and suffering against the animal which ultimately resulted in the animals death.

The investigation revealed two witnesses from the night of 07/29/2022 who heard the suspect beating the canine inside the residence. Both witnesses stated the suspect was intoxicated and went into the room with the dog. Both witnesses' say they heard the canine yelping and crying out in pain and heard "the suspect beating the canine to death." Both witnesses provided sworn statements and advised the door of the bedroom was locked, and they could not enter the room. The beating went on for several minutes, and did not hear from the dog or suspect after the crying stopped.

Another witness, the suspect's girlfriend, provided a sworn statement, stating she believes the suspect killed the canine and discovered the canine and the suspect at the residence the night of the incident. She became concerned for the canine as the dog was lethargic, unable to function, and near death. She stated when she arrived home, she and the

suspect took the dog to the emergency vet for treatment, where the canine expired. The suspect did not provide any explanation for the injuries.

All parties stated this is the second dog the suspect has killed in the last five months. Two witnesses report a history of domestic violence inside the residence. Video evidence of domestic violence and text messages support the witnesses' description of the event. They also report the suspect is suffering from a substance abuse problem.

On 08/11/2022, contact was made with the suspect, and he was placed under arrest. He provided:

- A post-Miranda sworn statement.
- Denied all allegations of animal abuse and domestic violence.
- Denied a substance abuse problem.

He was transported to Naples Jail Center by Marco Island Patrol units for processing.
